

Counseling Services

The guidance department will be open beginning at 7:30 each morning, at lunch and until 3:30 each afternoon. Students requiring guidance services in the morning should enter the building through the lobby after 7:30 and report directly to the guidance office. Counseling on an individual or small group basis is available to students. Guidance sessions with large groups will be conducted on various occasions throughout the school year.

- Personal Counseling – Students are led to increase personal growth, self-understanding and maturity.
- Career and Educational Counseling – Students are
 - led to evaluate their aptitudes, abilities and interests.
 - led to develop educational and occupational plans.
 - provided information about post-secondary educational institutions in which they express interest.
 - given information about the process of preparing for college and how to apply for financial aid and scholarships.
 - provided information about job opportunities (summer, part-time and full-time).
 - provided access to SCOIS (South Carolina Occupational Information System), a computerized method of delivering up-to-date career, educational and occupational information. Students may access this information in guidance, the library or the computer lab.
